Please note that sessions can only be booked more than three months in advance if the school has taken out a subscription to our service or undertakes to do so at the time of the first visit. Subscriptions cost £250 for Birmingham LEA schools and give access to four – six sessions every year. Additional sessions charged per head.

Sessions per head cost £2.50 per Birmingham LEA pupil for a standard half-day session. Sessions per head can only be booked three months in advance (four months in July).
