Roman Remains



Pupils learn about life as a Roman soldier by exploring a centurion's suit of armour. They will also have the opportunity to find out about everyday life in Roman times by handling artefacts and investigating clues from the past.

The Glory That Was Greece

Pupils use the Ancient Greek gallery as a resource to decide what our rich collection of ceramics can tell us about life in the past. They then have the chance to handle artefacts, learn about Greek gods and discover Greek patterns by designing their own pots.

Ancient Egypt

In this evidence-based handling session, children will get the chance to explore genuine Ancient Egyptian artefacts and discover the secrets of making an Egyptian mummy from the grisly beginnings all the way through to the bandaging which every pupil will have an opportunity to get involved in. The session covers aspects of Egyptian religious beliefs and is very interactive.



The Glittering Gold: Exploring Saxon Treasure

Pupils will investigate the mystifying history of the Hoard using storytelling and practical activities. Taking part in a combination of discussion and archaeological investigation using tools, pupils will explore the real meaning of the Hoard's burial and the methods behind its discovery.

Each booked class will receive a morning or afternoon teaching session led by a member of the Learning team.
