

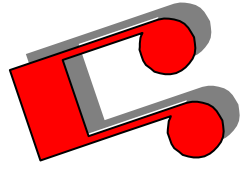
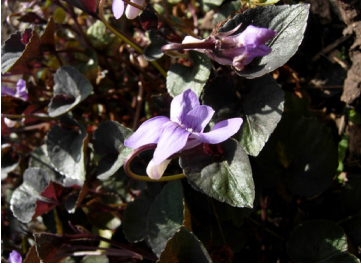
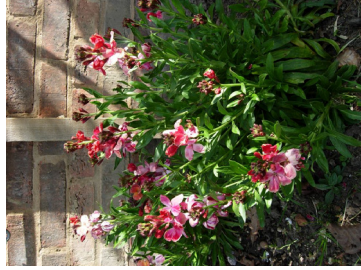
# I can sing a rainbow....

The herb garden at Blakesley Hall Museum is a very colourful place.

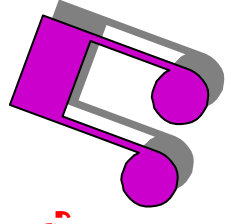
People used to use herbs when they cooked and to make medicines.

I can sing a rainbow, sing a rainbow, sing a rainbow too.'**



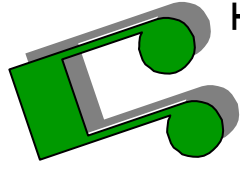
# Use your sense of smell!

In the past people used herbs when they cooked food and when they made medicines.

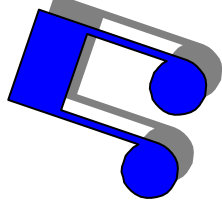
Lots of these herbs have a smell.
